The Heart of Fit for Mission

Fit for Mission is pioneering a new way of working to grow and sustain the Church for future generations.

We are asking God for a bigger church so we can make a bigger difference; more people knowing Jesus and more justice in the world.

Vision Statement of Diocese of Liverpool

Following the teaching of Jesus, Christian worshipping communities have rooted themselves in the *Great Commission* to **share the good news** of Jesus Christ (Matthew 28:16-20) and the *Great Commandment* to **show love** to our neighbours (Matthew 22:39). Through acts of sharing and showing our faith, we live out our missional vision by: introducing people to Jesus, deepening discipleship, developing Christian Leaders and working for justice.

Discerning our Vision and Mission

Over the next few weeks we will begin to answer two questions: What is God calling us to accomplish (vision) and What is God calling us to do (mission).



Through May and June, we completed two tasks: Community Assessment and Parish Laity Survey (70 responses).

DISCOVER

On Sunday 7th July (following morning services), we hosted an Vision Workshop (100+ participants) to share the results of the parish survey, and the findings of a community assessment report. We will have a report for you to review before the end of July.



Naming our New Parish— Recently, we launched a request for a potential new name for one New Parish to encompass the FfM churches. If you have a name you would like to submit, send your idea here: clayton.rowe@liverpool.anglican.org.

On Sunday 8th September (following morning services), we will gather clergy and 3-5 lay representatives to engage in a Mission Workshop to draft missional goals to achieve as a larger parish.

Beginning on Tuesday 8th October - 19th November, we invite you to participate in <u>Cultivate</u>, a lay discipleship and leadership programme, to increase our ability to share and show our faith. We will host a daytime event (10am-12pm) and an evening event (7-9pm). More information to come.

Then in the New Year, Tuesday 14th January - 18th February, we will have a special focus on justice with a series of workshops with <u>Together Liverpool</u>. More information to come.
