Seeking our Vision

On 7 July over 100 individuals from across the Toxteth, Wavertree, and the Dingle gathered to begin the process of seeing what God can do with and through our parishes. A summary report and full version of the report will be sent to parishes for Sunday 18 August.

Deciding our One Larger Parish Name

During July we had over 30 names submitted for our one Larger Parish name. Three potential names are being put forward for your consideration.

We ask each person to choose their top name with their **one** vote. You can vote through a paper ballot at your local parish by **Sunday 25 August 2024**.

Remember, your local parish will keep it current name and the name of the one larger parish will simply hold us together as one larger parish.



On Sunday 8 September (following morning services), we will gather 3-4 clergy and lay representatives to engage in a Mission Workshop to draft missional goals to achieve as a larger parish in the next year.

Beginning on Tuesday 8th October— 19 November, we invite you to participate in <u>Cultivate</u>, a lay discipleship and leadership program, to increase our ability to share and show our faith. We will host a day time event (10-12:00 pm) and an evening event (7:00-9:00pm). You can sign-up at your local parish or <u>online</u>.

Then in the New Year, Tuesday 14th January—18th February, we will have a special focus on justice with a series of workshops with <u>Together Liverpool</u>. More information to come.
