FFM Update

Toxteth & Wavertree June 2025



During May the PCCs of 9 Toxteth and Wavertree Deanery Fit for Mission churches undertook confirmatory decisions on whether to continue working towards becoming a larger single parish in the Fit for Mission programme.

Six of the nine churches voted yes, saying they would continue to work together in this way.

On Monday 2 June, the Area Dean, and Change Lead met with Archdeacon Miranda and Fit for Mission representatives to review the outcome of the PCC decisions.

It was decided that these six churches are viable to become a larger single parish, and these churches will continue to collaborate to fulfil this vision.

Hope Parish Liverpool will comprise the following churches:

- Christ Church Toxteth Park
- St Bede with St Clement
- St Bridget and St Thomas
- St Gabriel and Cleopas
- St Luke-in-the-City
- St Margaret of Antioch

We would like to thank all those who have given their time to Fit for Mission, and to the PCCs for their prayerful and detailed discernment of the future of their churches.


